II. UWW

- x 21 people attended the faculty only meetinghteptevious Friday, February 13. Only a handful of those people were not on FEC, CEPP or the UWW Working Group.
- x Discussion at the meeting centered on the process of the study, including the extent of the working group's charged how itswork was portrayed in the final report.
- x Some consideration was also given to the projections for faculty workload in the proposal
- x There was a suggestion that the handbook should have language that is concerned with programs (rather than using the section on departments as a model).
- x FEC considered whether a 2/3 majority vote should be required to eliminate a program
- x It was argued that we do not require a 2/3 majority to establish a program and therefore should not require it to end a program.
- x Others noted that the faculty handbook does not currently have language to that effect and such a change should be considered by the entire faculty.
- x FEC determined that in this case it could not ask for a 2/3 majority vote to approve the motion.
